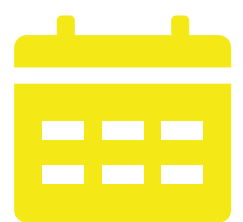

She led the Catalan Agency for Health Technology Assessment and Research, where she initially developed her research career. Later on, she joined the University of Girona, where she was a professor at the School of Medicine. She chairs the Public Health Society of Catalonia and Balearic Islands, and sits on the PAHO Strategic Advisory Group on Information Systems and Digital Transformation of Health.
